Year 11 into Year 12 - Chemistry

In order to bridge the gap between GCSE and A level, students are expected to obtain a copy of the CGP Head Start to A-Level Chemistry (ISBN 978 1 78294 280 1). This guide is available from bookshops and covers every essential GCSE topic and new A Level concepts, including clear notes and practice questions.

All students should:

- 1. study the topics covered in the book, with particular emphasis on making links between topics studied at GCSE and those which will be introduced at A level, and
- 2. complete all practice questions.

During the first week of teaching, students will be examined on the content to test their understanding of the topics in the CGP Head Start to A-Level Chemistry guide.
