

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

There is another path to take ... A Traineeship




The impact of Traineeships

What is a Traineeship?





Short & flexible programme




Develop skills & gains qualifications



At least 70 hours of work experience



Last between 6 weeks to 12 months



Lead to employment, an apprenticeship or further education



How does a Traineeship work?



It's a flexible programme which provides:

- Work preparation training
- Interview preparation and CV writing
- Job searching support
- Development of interpersonal skills
- Meaningful work experience in local area
- Development of workplace skills
- English, Maths and Digital Skills tutoring
- Employability skills
- On completion a written reference and possibly an interview
- Confidence building

Motivated to work



Eligibility to work in the UK



Little or no work experience



Aged 16-24 or 25 on an EHCP

Level 3

No qualifications above GCSE level (Level 3 or equivalent)



Money mattters




- The training is free

We began offering Traineeships in September to provide an opportunity for young people to experience a real working environment and for our store partners to recognise the young talent available. So far, we have had 16 trainees and 10 out of those have now been offered a job with 9 about to start their Apprenticeship. We have a further 24 vacancies and we have been amazed at the continuing quality of candidates presented by our partner Qube throughout


