- ¹ The Music Practical exams will take place in the Music rooms; please see the Head of Department for exact location.

- ³ The Art Practical exam will take place during your timetabled double lesson; please see the Head of Department for exact date. Art – Photography exam will take place in P9 during your timetabled lesson.
- ⁴ The Music Listening exam will take place in B2. Please line up outside B2 for this exam.
- Students who have Access Arrangements will be taking their exams in B1 or B2 in the Sixth Form and students will be informed prior to the practice exams which room they will be in and the Access Arrangements they will be entitled to.

Please Note:

- Morning exams will start at **8.30am** and afternoon exams will start at **1.15pm**. Students must be ready to line up in the Main Hall 15 minutes before the start of an exam for morning and afternoon exams. **If you are late for your exam you will not be entitled to the time that you have missed.** The length of each exam is shown in brackets [].
- All Bags and coats must be placed in the container located between the Sports Hall and the ICT rooms **before** you line up for your exams in the School Hall or B1/B2.
- You must write in black ink.
- You must not have any calculator lids or glasses cases with you. You are not allowed to leave them under your desk.
- Maths sets/tins are not permitted; empty the contents and leave the case/tin at home.
- Drink bottles should be free from any labels.
- Pencil cases must be transparent (not coloured).
- Your pockets need to be empty. Do not bring in any notes/papers with you in your pockets as you will be disqualified from the examination and be awarded zero marks.

These exams will take place under full examination conditions. Please ensure that you do not take your mobile phone or MP3 player/i-pod/watches etc. into the exam. Any student found to have these items or any other unauthorised items in their possession in the exam room will be disqualified.
