

Park High Sixth Form Entry Requirements September 2024

For A Level programmes:

- ✓ Students must achieve at least **six 9-4 grades including English Language and Mathematics at GCSE.**
- ✓ Students must meet the GCSE requirements for the A-Level subjects they would like to study from the lists below.

Section A

The following subjects have the following GCSE requirements:

A-level Subject	GCSE Requirements
Biology	Grade 6 in Biology and 6 in Chemistry or Physics or 6-6 in Combined Science & 5 in English Language & 5 in Mathematics
Chemistry	Grade 6 in Chemistry and 6 in Biology or Physics or 6-6 in Combined Science & 5 in Mathematics
Physics	Grade 6 in Physics and a 6 in Biology or Chemistry or 6-6 in Combined Science & 6 in Mathematics
Computer Science	Grade 6 in Computer Science or 6 in Mathematics
D&T- Product Design	Grade 6 in Mathematics, and either Grade 6 in D&T or Distinction Level 2 in Vocational Engineering
Economics	Grade 6 in Mathematics & 5 in English Language
English Literature	Grade 5 and 6 in either English Literature or Language
Art, Craft & Design	Grade 5 in Art or portfolio / interview
History	Grade 6 in History or a related subject
Mathematics	Grade 6 in Mathematics
Further Mathematics	Grade 8 in Mathematics
Philosophy and Ethics	Grade 5 in P&E and 5 in English Language
Physical Education	Grade 5 in Physical Education
Politics	Grade 5 in English Language
Psychology	Grade 5 in Mathematics & 5 in English Language
Sociology	Grade 5 in English Language
Spanish	Grade 6 in Spanish

Section B

The following subjects do not require you to have studied them in advance, but if they have been studied at GCSE, a **Grade 5 or above** must have been achieved. If they haven't been studied at GCSE, then **Grade 5 in English Language and Mathematics** must have been achieved.

Business	If studied Grade 5 in Business
Drama	If studied Grade 5 in Drama
Media	If studied Grade 5 in Media
Photography	If studied Grade 5 in Art or portfolio/interview

Other subjects offered within the Collegiate can be taken as 'away subjects' at a different centre, if not offered at Park High. The entry criteria for these will be decided by the centre offering the course.
