Please Note:

- Morning exams will start at 8.30am and afternoon exams will start at 1.30pm. Students **MUST** be ready 15 minutes before the start of an exam for both morning and afternoon exams. **If you are late for your exam, you will not be entitled to the time that you have missed.** The length of each exam is shown in brackets [].
- All written exams will be taking place in the Sixth Form Block B5/B6
- Students who have Access Arrangements will be taking their exams in B7 in the Sixth Form. Students will be informed prior to the practice exams which room they will be in and the Access Arrangements they will be entitled to
- All students' bags and coats/jackets must be placed in the common room located in the Sixth Form Block before you line up for your exam.
- You must write in black ink.
- You must not have any calculator lids or glasses cases with you. You are not allowed to leave them under your desk.
