### **Review Day 1 – Thursday 16 October 2025**

At Park High School, we believe in *investing in each other to be the very best we can be*. This ethos underpins everything we do, and Review Day is a key moment in the school year where we come together - students, staff, and families - to reflect, celebrate progress, and plan for future success.

Review Day is designed to support meaningful conversations about your child's learning, behaviour, and engagement with the wide range of opportunities available at Park High. It is a time for students to demonstrate resilience in reflecting on their journey so far, curiosity in setting goals for the future, and integrity in owning their progress. It will also be a valuable opportunity to explore your child's engagement with the core principles of learning at Park High, known as the P's of Learning:

- Prepare for Learning
- Proactive in Lessons
- Pride in Presentation
- Persist After Lessons

These principles help guide students in becoming thoughtful, motivated learners, and your involvement in discussing them reinforces the strong partnership between home and school.

On **Thursday 16 October**, normal lessons will be suspended. Students will attend school only for their scheduled appointment with their tutor. Appointments will run from 8:30am to 3.15pm, although some tutors may offer times outside of this window. In some cases, students may be invited to attend their review meeting on an alternative day if needed.

When not in school, students are expected to continue their learning at home. Work and enrichment activities will be available via Microsoft Teams, and students will also complete the October 2025 Student Voice survey.

We strongly encourage all parents and carers to attend their child's review meeting. Tutors will have prepared thoroughly, gathering insights into academic progress, behaviour, and personal development. Your presence helps reinforce the shared commitment between home and school to support your child's growth and success.
