

OUR AGREEMENT



At Park we believe that education is a three way process involving a genuine partnership between school, parent or carer and student. We base this partnership on agreement and understanding in two vital areas. First, what the school stands for in terms of its ethos and values. We ask everyone involved in the school to share and uphold these. Second, our partnership is based on recognising and carrying out our respective responsibilities whether we are students, teachers, parents or carers. The Park High School Agreement describes these responsibilities.

It is a voluntary agreement designed to establish the relationship between home and school on a basis of mutual trust and openness. We ask each parent or carer and student intending to join the school to consider the Agreement carefully before signing it together with the Form Tutor; there is also a copy in each pupil's Contact Book which we also ask you to sign.

- Deliver promptly to my parents/carers all letters and communications from the school
- Use the School's computer hardware and software responsibly, according to school guidelines
- Make the most of the opportunities at Park to develop my potential
- Complete all work set to the best of my ability, including homework

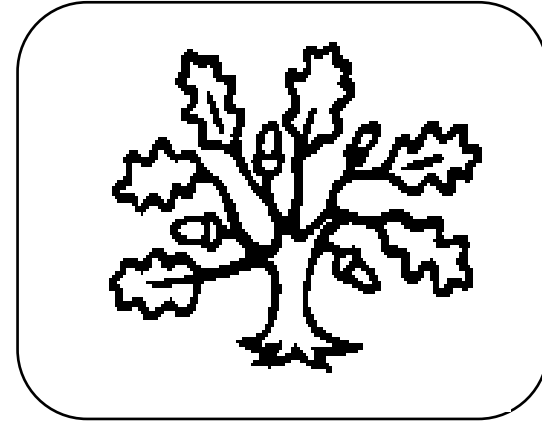
