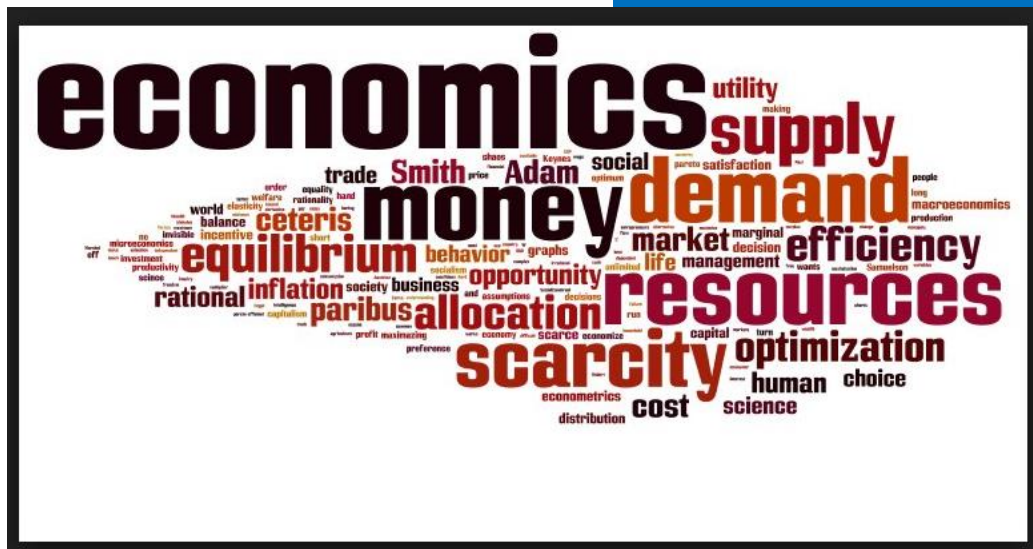


Year 13 Economics Bridging work

Before you return to Economics in September, you need to complete the following tasks...



- ✓ 1) Buy a folder and some dividers (pack of ten)
- ✓ 2) Complete all definitions for each micro chapter. (yes, **all** of them...you have 6 weeks)
- ✓ 3) Over the summer, collect news articles and headlines relating to ANY topic in Economics and summarise the key issues within the news story. You may decide to produce this in the form of a scrapbook. You can look for any news stories concerning to the UK economy, the European economy, or the world economy. Be prepared to share your ideas and discuss these news headlines with your peers in September!
- ✓ 4) Revisit all of the Year 1 content and ensure you have filled in any gaps in your knowledge. This will mean you need to make sure your notes are up to date and detailed, you may want to go through exam papers and plan more essays, or tackle multiple choice etc.
- ✓ 5) Print off Paper 1, 2 and 3 of the A Level Specimen papers on the AQA website (not AS). Produce a brief summary sheet describing the structure of each paper.
